COPY FORMATS

We accept documents in the following formats:

InDesign CC, Photoshop CC, Illustrator CC;

Generic **JPEG**, **TIFF**, **EPS** or **PDF** files are also acceptable, but must meet the image, font and size specifications below.

Microsoft **Word** files are acceptable.

We **CANNOT** use Corel documents.

DIMENSIONS (in millimetres)

Full page: A4 186w x 270h Half page: Landscape: 186w x132h Portrait: 91w x 270h Quarter page: 91w x 132h Eight page: 91w x 62h Sixteenth page: 42w x 62h

Full page with bleed: A4 210w x 297h PLUS 3mm bleed.

DPS with bleed: A3 420w x 297h PLUS 3mm bleed, with 24mm total gutter.

TEXT

Advert wording must be specified; brochures and tear sheets are not acceptable as copy. Text may be edited to fit the available space. The position of any editorial agreed for inclusion in Country Images is decided by the editor and will not necessarily be on the same page as your advert.

IMAGES

Digital images are welcome in EPS, TIFF or JPEG format but **must** have at least <u>300</u> <u>pixel-per-inch (PPI)</u> resolution at print size.

JPEGs should be at low compression (high file size).

Images meant for display on computer screens are normally at 72PPI and therefore will print at only about a quarter of their original size. Images (including logos) copied from Web pages are not normally of sufficient size or image quality for print use.

Photos are acceptable for scanning provided they are good quality (these will be returned on request).

FONTS

Any special typefaces required for your ad must be supplied, either embedded in a made-up PDF file, outlined in an EPS or included as <u>Macintosh</u> font files/suitcases. To be usable, PostScript type 1 fonts require both the screen font suitcase and the corresponding PostScript font file(s). We reserve the right to approximate unavailable fonts at our discretion.
